Brief Agency History: Since its inception in 1949, the focus of the Alcoholism Council has been to reduce problems related to alcoholism and other drug addictions through the delivery of treatment and prevention services. The Council has a wide range of programs that serve children, adolescents, families, women, older adults as well as persons with co-occurring substance abuse and mental health disorders. In July of 2003, the Council expanded its ability to provide assessment, referral and treatment for individual and family counseling with the introduction of the Recovery Health Access Center (RHAC) project. For over 50 years, the Council's information and referral services have provided a central point of access to the existing public system of care.

Services Provided: Assessment, Case Management, Crisis Intervention, Group Counseling, Individual Counseling, Community Services (Consultation, Referral & Information), Prevention Services (Alternatives, Community Based process, Education, Information Dissemination, Environmental), AOD not classified.

Target Population: Children, Adolescents, Families, Women, Older adults and persons with co-occurring substance abuse and mental health disorders

Major Programs: Out Patient Treatment, Men's Early Intervention Group, Men & Women's Relapse Prevention Group, Alcohol & Drug Education Program, Family Intervention, Kid's Connection, Youth Mentoring (TREND), KUUMBA Summer Enrichment Program, IMPACT Care Management, Recovery Health Access Center (RHAC), HC Juvenile TASC, American Sign Language Interpretation, Substance Abuse Management Services (SAMS), HC Teen Institute/Junior Teen Institute, Drug Free Workplace Intervention Network Employee Assistance Program, Community Based Prevention.
