**Brief Agency History:** Beech Acres Parenting Center, originally known as the German General Protestant Orphan Home, began in 1849. In 1950, the agency moved to Anderson Township and changed its name to Beech Acres. For more than 30 years, Beech Acres housed orphans whom lost their parents when a cholera epidemic ravaged the city. Today, Beech Acres focuses on helping children, parents and families by providing support, education and resources. Guided by the agency's mission of strengthening families and children, Beech Acres Parenting Center has become a force in the community to help parents raise their children.

**Services Provided:** Pharmacologic Management, MH Assessment Non-physician, BH Counseling and Therapy - Individual, BH Counseling and Therapy – Group, Partial Hospitalization, Community Psychiatric Supportive Treatment - Individual. Other Mental Health: School Based Services, Family Peer Support, School Coordination and Intervention.
