**Brief Agency History:** The Center for Chemical Addictions Treatment has provided services to chemically dependant adults since its incorporation in June 1970. At that time, the agency was known as the Center for Comprehensive Alcoholism Treatment (CCAT). In 1975, CCAT's detox center became known as the first stand alone drug treatment center to receive its accreditation from the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Hospitals. In 1981, CCAT merged with the Cincinnati Alcoholism Rehabilitation Enterprises (CARE, Inc.) and moved into the former nunnery where it resides today. The move allowed CCAT to provide a continuum of services in one location in response to the growing needs of the community. In 1994, the agency changed its name to the Center for Chemical Addictions Treatment to reflect the change in the types of services it provided. Over the past 36 years, thousands of people have walked through CCAT's doors looking for a better life through sobriety and CCAT has been there to help.

**Services Provided:** Sub-Acute Detox, Non-Medical Community Residential Treatment, Intensive Outpatient.
