**Brief Agency History:** Central Community Health Board (CCHB) was founded in 1970 with a mission to promote the betterment of the health of Hamilton County residents through coordination of comprehensive mental health and drug abuse services. The Narcotics Addiction Program (NAP) began operations in 1971 and the Mental Health Center opened in 1972. CCHB's original mission was to concentrate in the communities of Avondale, North Avondale, Clifton, Fairview-Clifton Heights, Corryville, East End, Evanston, Mt. Adams, Mt. Auburn, Walnut Hills, East Walnut Hills, West End and Over-the-Rhine. Through a contract relationship with the Mental Health and Recovery Services Board, its mental health services spanned county-wide in 1986. In 1997, the Board outsourced the Residential Community Mental Health Home Program, formerly operated by Board employees, to Central Community Health Board.
