Brief Agency History: The mission statement of Camelot Community Care is: To develop and provide services which enable children and families to realize their own potential. These services must recognize the feelings and protect the rights of the clients. Camelot, founded in 1974, provides home and community based therapeutic services to SED children, adolescents and their families in the states of: Florida, Illinois, Indiana, Michigan and Texas and since 1999 in Ohio. Service delivery is provided in the families' natural environment, i.e. the home and the child's school. Camelot currently serves residents of Hamilton, Butler and Clermont counties.

Services Provided: Pharmacologic Management, MH Assessment Non-physician, BH Counseling and Therapy – Individual and Community Psychiatric Supportive Treatment – Individual, Community Psychiatric Supportive Treatment – Group, Other MH – In-Home Behavioral Management.
