Brief Agency History: Catholic Charities Southwestern Ohio established in 1914 is an agency of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. Formerly known as Catholic Social Services of Southwest Ohio, the agency exists to advance the human dignity and welfare of those people in need by providing comprehensive social services primarily to the needy and low income population. Catholic Social Service began contracting with the Board in 1996 to provide an array of services to the inner city mentally ill adult, child and adolescent population.
