Brief Agency History: The Children's Home of Cincinnati, Inc. was founded in 1864 in the context of a national reform movement eliminating reliance on placing the mentally ill in asylums or institutions. The Children's Home was committed to provide a "genuine and not an institution home; a home with a father and mother in it, and a family life, and individuality of development and experience." Today Children's Home offers over twenty programs and services in for district areas intended to improve the lives of children and their families.

Services Provided: Pharmacologic Management, MH Assessment Non-physician, BH Counseling and Therapy - Individual, BH Counseling and Therapy – Group, Community Psychiatric Supportive Treatment - Individual, Partial Hospitalization
