Brief Agency History: The Crossroads Center began as a contract agency with the Board in the 1980's. Their primary focus is to implement state of the art programs that promote abstinence, prevent or remediate substance abuse and mental illness, and other behavioral disorders that place families and children at risk.

Services Provided: Pharmacologic Management, MH Assessment Non-physician, Psychiatric Diagnostic Interview w/ Physician, BH Counseling and Therapy - Individual, BH Counseling and Therapy – Group. Other Mental Health – Court Residential Services, Court Testimony, Scoring & Analysis; AOD: Assessment, Case Management, Crisis Intervention, Family Counseling, Group Counseling, Individual Counseling, Intensive Outpatient, Laboratory Urinalysis, Medical Somatic, Community Services (Outreach, Referral & Information, Information Dissemination Training), Prevention Services (Alternatives, Community Based Process, Education, Environmental, Problem Identification & Referral), Residential Care.

Child - Severely Emotionally Disabled
Child & Adult – Alcohol and Drug Addiction Service
