**Brief Agency History:** In 1879 Associated Charities was founded in response to a city wide cry for relief in the midst of a small pox epidemic, flooding and issues from poor sanitation and dilapidated housing. The agency was originally developed as a relief organization that blossomed into a social service agency. In 1960, Associated Charities changed their name to Family Service of the Cincinnati Area and expanded their focus to provide an array of outpatient mental health programs servicing adults and children. To date, Family Service continues to meet the needs of children, families and adults in Hamilton County.
