Brief Agency History: In 1971 Cincinnati Restoration Inc. was formed as a single half-way house for women. The agency added programs and staff over the years ultimately changing its name to CRI. In 1989 QCM Inc., was formed to provide intensive case management services. In July 2004, two independently managed mental health agencies, CRI and QCM, merged to establish Greater Cincinnati Behavioral Health Services (GCB). GCB was designed as the most comprehensive community-based resource in the Greater Cincinnati area for clients with a severe mental illness. Serving over 4,000 clients, GCB provides housing, recovery, case management, psychiatric supportive community based services, employment/vocational services and other support services.

Services Provided: Pharmacologic Management, Psychiatric Diagnostic Interview w/ physician, Community Psychiatric Supportive Treatment - Individual, Community Psychiatric Supportive Treatment - Group, MH Assessment Non-physician, BH Counseling and Therapy - Individual, BH Counseling and Therapy - Group, Employment/Vocational Service, Consumer Operated Service. Other Mental Health Service: Co-Treatment, Community Residence, Referral & Information Service, PATH, Psychosocial Rehabilitative Support
