Brief Agency History: Glad House opened its doors in 1998 as a residential program providing holistic intensive treatment for children aged 5 – 11 years, whose parents are active in drug/alcohol treatment. As the agency population expanded, it became prevalent the parents of children being served were dealing with co-occurring substance abuse and mental illness. In response to this, Glad House began contracting with the Board to provide these children intensive mental health and alcohol and drug treatment.
