Brief Agency History: The Health Resource Center (HRC) began in 1995 as a nurse managed urgent care medical and mental health clinic serving homeless or indigent persons in the Over-The-Rhine area of Cincinnati. HRC is known as the “safety-net provider” of the mental health system in Hamilton County. It is an independent 501(C)3 non-profit agency located inside the FreeStore FoodBank building on Liberty St. in Over the Rhine. HRC has served mentally ill residents since the 90’s who have not been able to get their health care needs met through traditional resources. In 2007 to address the needs of its dually diagnosed population, HRC became certified by The Ohio Department of Alcohol and Drug Addiction Services to provide an Outpatient Treatment Program.
