Brief Agency History: The Hamilton County Juvenile Court was founded in 1904 as the third juvenile court in the United States. The Court has jurisdiction to hear and determine all cases involving children in Hamilton County. Additionally, the Court administers programs and facilities providing for the rehabilitation and treatment of youth. Mental Health Services are primarily provided through the Court Clinic located within the Juvenile Detention facility located at 2020 Auburn Avenue and at Hillcrest Training School located in Springfield Township. In 2004, in partnership with the Hamilton County Mental Health Board, the Court launched Ohio's first juvenile mental health court.
